Now the expression looks more pathetic. I minimized the reflection on the boots as old boots cannot reflect that much of light. There are more objects on her belts including an extra ammo drum and a TT-33 handgun. I spent a long-time doing research and finding examples of the gun. This is my first time drawing a proper gun and I am satisfied of my outcome. For the first time, and only for now.
